

# NEWSLETTER Pre k 3 and 4 year old classes

Dear Parents,

We're winding down the school year and keeping very busy. Please arrive on time so your child participates in all of our school day. Thanks for all you do to help us each day! I hope this list of dates is helpful with all our End of Year activities.

Wed, April 19 – is the LAST day to order and pay \$12.00 for a class photo

Wed, April 26 and Thurs, April 27 PreK classes are walking across the street to hear CLIS Band.

Friday, April 28 – CCISD Early Release Day – NO Early Release for us.

Summer Schoolabaloo registration continues. Sign your child up for Tue, Wed and Thurs classes during June and July so they can enjoy “If You Give a Kid a Book.” Tell your family and friends. All children registered for Schoolabaloo must pay the full tuition amount by Friday, May 26. Mon, May 1 - LAST day for early registration (\$35.00). Registration fee increases to \$45.00 after May 1.

Tues, May 9 and Wed, May 10 - PreK Pet Day

On Tues, May 9 – Mrs. Wroblewski, Lenz, Maas, McCabe (TTh) & Olguin’s classes bring pets.

On Wed, May 10 – Mrs. French, Armstrong/Fossati, McCabe (MWF) & Auger’s classes bring pets.

All children will go out both days to see the pets. On your child’s “Pet Day”, parents may bring their child’s pet to school. **\*NOTE: Please be sure pets are up to date with vaccinations.** We will meet outside at 9:00am. Please plan on spending the 1½ hours (from 9:00am – 10:30am) with us, so ALL the classes will see ALL the pets. Parents MUST stay and attend to their own pets. (Bring a blanket or chair to sit on!) All classes will follow a schedule and the children will come out with their teachers to look, touch and visit. To help us plan for “Pet Day” on May 9 and May 10, your teacher will post a sign-up sheet. Hope you can come and share with us. We’re looking forward to seeing you and your birds, cats, gerbils, bunnies, hamsters, dogs, turtles...

May 7 – May tuition is due. Please avoid late fees. We will close out our books on Thursday, May 11. Thank you.

Thurs, May 18 – PreK End of Year Program for ALL classes – Wed classes are invited to attend Thurs May 18!

Classes meet from 9am – Noon. NOON dismissal on both days – for ALL classes

Letters will be mailed mid-August with the start of school information. BE SURE and have your child’s Immunization Record and Signed Doctor’s Statement completed during the summer. All returning students MUST resubmit this paperwork.
