#### **Profession of Faith**

the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified,


who has spoken through the prophets.



# Liturgy of the Eucharist








At the conclusion of the prayer, all respond: Amen.




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#### **Memorial Acclamation**

After the priest says or sings: "The mystery of faith," all respond



#### Pange lingua gloriosi corporis mysterium.


Translation: Tell, tongue, the mystery of the glorious Body.


